FAQs for Merit List Preparation

1. What is the criterion for Calculation of ECA, LOR, Vocational Subject & Ward of DSEU Faculty Score?

For calculating the weightage for ECA, LOR, Vocational Subject & Ward of DSEU Faculty Score, the total score of ECA is calculated as per the details mentioned in the Information Bulletin and as per the documents submitted by the candidate at the time of filling of the form. To the ECA Score 1 mark for LOR is added (subject to the valid LOR document provided by the candidate). Further, 1 Mark each is added for Vocational Subject as per the list of Vocational Subjects of CBSE based on the qualifying exam. Lastly, 1 Mark is added for the candidates who are ward of DSEU faculty. The Total Score thus obtained is converted to the scale of 10.

ECA + LOR + Vocational Subject + Ward of DSEU Faculty Score = Total Score carries 10% weightage.

Example: If the maximum of ECA is 20 mark, LOR has maximum of 1 mark, Vocational Subject has maximum of 1 mark, and Ward of DSEU Faculty has maximum of 1 mark, thus if the total maximum is 23 marks. These 23 marks are equivalent to a score of 10.

Thus if an applicant has got 1 mark, the equivalent score is $1 \times 10/23 = 0.43$; if an applicant has got 2 marks, the equivalent score is $2 \times 10/23 = 0.86$, and so on. Similarly if the applicant has got 23 marks, the equivalent score is $2 \times 10/23 = 10$.

2. What is the criterion for Calculation of CUET score?

CUET Mapping followed for admissions to various degree programs can be found at the link below:

The CUET score has been calculated based on the percentile score submitted by the applicants of relevant/applicable subjects as per the mapping available on the link above.

Example: If an applicant has applied for BCA and submitted a CUET percentile score of Maths and Computer Science. Average of Maths and Computer Science percentile score will be considered for calculating the CUET score.

3. What is the criterion for calculating the final merit?

The final merit for UG Programs (except B.A. Digital Media & Design and B.Tech. Programs) has been calculated as per the below given criterion:

Academic Performance in Class XII carrying 80% weightage

+

ECA + LOR + Vocational Subject + Ward of DSEU Faculty Score carrying 10% weightage

+

CUET carrying 10% weightage

Example;

If an applicant has score 70% in class 12th, it will be equivalent to $70 \times 80/100 = 70 \times 0.8 = 56$ merit score.

Now, if this applicant has got 10 marks for ECA, and has submitted valid LOR at the time of application, has studied relevant vocational subject in 12th class, and is a ward of faculty of DSEU, the merit score for ECA, LOR, Vocational Subject & Ward of DSEU Faculty would be:

 $[(10+1+1+1) \times 10/23] = 13 \times 0.43 = 5.59$ (Assuming the maximum score in that merit list is 23)

Further, if this applicant has submitted Mathematics percentile score as 62.45, and Computer Science percentile score as 72.68, and has applied for BCA program. His CUET score would be (62.45 + 72.68)/2 = 67.565.

In total merit calculation, CUET score carries 10% weightage, therefore CUET merit score would be $67.565 \times 10/100 = 6.7565$.

Total Merit Score = 56 + 5.59 + 6.7565 = 68.3465.
